



ANGMERING CLUSTER TABLE TENNIS (Year 5 and 6)

Each school should have 4 players per team.

There can be any mix of gender.

Players should be seeded in order of ability from 1 (best) to 4.

Matches will be the first to 11.

Each school should provide an umpire / scorer.

Where possible matches will be played on full size table tennis tables.

If these are not available, matches can be played on dining tables.

Make shift nets can be used if none others are available.

Players will play against the respectively seeded players from other schools in a round robin format.

Players winning their match will get 3 points. Losing players will get 1 point.

The group winner will be decided by the player who achieves the most wins.

Matches will be the first to 11 points.

Each player will take two consecutive serves.

Serves should bounce on each side of the net and be served from behind the back of the table.

Points are won if a player hits the ball to bounce on the opposite side of the net and the opponent misses the ball or fails to return it onto the player's side of the table.

Players are not allowed to put their hand on the table surface – this leads to a point for their opponent.

Players should be encouraged NOT to volley the ball.

If a player volleys the ball the umpire will decide if the ball was going to miss the table. If it was the point will be made for the volleying player. If it wasn't the point will be made for the other player.

Players should not hit the tables with their bats under any circumstances.

Upon completion of the round robin format, each player will gain points corresponding to their final group position. The lowest placed will receive 1 point, second lowest will receive 2 points, etc...

The scores for each school from each group will be added together to find the winning school.
